

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to www.riverworksonline.org and RiverWorks Community Development and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to RiverWorks Community Development include www.riverworksonline.org and RiverWorks. The RiverWorks website is used to inform clients and the general public about the services we offer to our community; we also have an opportunity for our supporters to donate online. By using the RiverWorks website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

In order to better provide you with information and services offered on our Site, RiverWorks may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name
- Mailing Address
- E-mail Address
- Phone Number

If you donate online or purchase an event ticket, RiverWorks's will collect credit card information. This information is used to complete the online donation.

Use of your Personal Information

RiverWorks collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested (online donation or event tickets).

RiverWorks may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other events or services available from RiverWorks and its community partners.

Sharing Information with Third Parties

RiverWorks does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

RiverWorks may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of a community partner about a particular offering/event that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party.

RiverWorks may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on RiverWorks or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of RiverWorks; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of RiverWorks, or the public.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by RiverWorks. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the RiverWorks website.

- SSL Protocol

We strive to take appropriate security measures to protect against unauthorized access to or alteration of your personal information. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet or any wireless network can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect your personal information, you acknowledge that: (a) there are security and privacy limitations inherent to the Internet which are beyond our control; and (b) security, integrity, and privacy of any and all information and data exchanged between you and us through this Site cannot be guaranteed.

Children Under Thirteen

RiverWorks does not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from children under the age of thirteen. If you are under the age of thirteen, you must ask your parent or guardian for permission to use this website.
